1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to health; prohibiting the regulation of international health organization;
1.3 proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 145.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. [145.661] INTERNATIONAL HEALTH REGULATIONS.

1.6 Subdivision 1. Prohibition on regulation of international health organization's
1.7 regulations. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no state agency, political
1.8 subdivision, or other governmental entity in the state shall enact or enforce any law, rule,
1.9 regulation, or other advisory or guidance that regulates or attempts to regulate the
1.10 health-related regulation of an international health organization unless the international
1.11 health organization's health-related regulation is enacted through legislation or a signed
1.12 executive order.

1.13 (b) For the purposes of this section, an "international health organization" means any
1.14 organization, agency, or entity established by international agreement or treaty to promote,
1.15 protect, or improve public health worldwide.

1.16 Subd. 2. Construction. This section shall not be construed to prohibit the state of
1.17 Minnesota from enforcing any federal law or regulation applicable to an international health
1.18 organization.
