1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to human services; providing housing support supplementary services
1.3 rates for certain facilities; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 256I.05, by
1.4 adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 256I.05, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 1v. Supplementary rate for certain facilities. Notwithstanding the provisions
1.9 of subdivisions 1a and 1c, beginning July 1, 2025, an agency shall negotiate a supplementary
1.10 rate in addition to the rate specified in subdivision 1 for a housing support provider operating
1.11 indoor communities with low barriers to access. The communities must: (1) be composed
1.12 of individual secure, private dwellings for persons experiencing unsheltered homelessness
1.13 with complex health needs including substance use disorder, serious mental illness, and
1.14 physical health conditions; and (2) provide 24-hour-a-day supervision with on-site support
1.15 services for 100 beds in the Twin Cities metropolitan area in a facility operating since 2020
1.16 and 48 beds in central Minnesota in a facility opening after 2025. The supplementary rate
1.17 is not to exceed \$975 per month, including any legislatively authorized inflationary
1.18 adjustments.
