1.9	an event venue that hosts celebrations, receptions, private parties, or other social gatherings,
1.10	including but not limited to those connected to weddings, funerals, life milestones, family
1.11	reunions, planned religious services, and other similar occasions may operate at 50 percent
1.12	capacity, if the business develops and implements a COVID-19 safety plan.
