1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. MORATORIUM ON USE OF BODY CAMERAS.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Definitions. As used in this section, (1) "body camera device" means
1.7	a device worn by a peace officer that is capable of recording audio or video of the officer's
1.8	activities and interactions with others or collecting digital multimedia evidence as part
1.9	of an investigation; (2) "law enforcement agency" has the meaning given in Minnesota
1.10	Statutes, section 626.84, subdivision 1; and (3) "peace officer" has the meaning given in
1.11	Minnesota Statutes, section 626.84, subdivision 1.
1.12	Subd. 2. Moratorium. A chief law enforcement officer of a law enforcement agency
1.13	may not permit or require a peace officer under the chief law enforcement officer's authority
1.14	to use a body camera device during the performance of the peace officer's official duties.
