The Office of the Revisor of Statutes, a nonpartisan office of the Minnesota Legislature, is seeking temporary, part-time pages for the 2024 legislative session. Morning and afternoon shifts are available with some flexibility in scheduling. Positions would start in mid-January and extend to the end of the 2024 regular legislative session on May 20, 2024. This position requires you to work in-person. Employees are also required to work some evening and weekend hours as assigned.

Responsibilities include hand delivery of documents to legislators and staff; filing, copying, collating and assembling documents; handling office supplies with some heavy lifting; and other miscellaneous office duties as needed. Candidates must be able to work flexibly and cooperatively with many interested parties within strict time constraints.
