The Office of the Revisor of Statutes, a non-partisan office of the Minnesota Legislature, is seeking applicants to fill temporary, part-time Page positions for the 2026 legislative session. These are limited term positions. Morning and afternoon shifts are available with some flexibility in scheduling. It is anticipated that positions would start in mid to late January and extend to the end of the 2026 regular legislative session on May 18, 2026. These positions require you to be non-partisan and work inperson. Employees are also required to work some evening and weekend hours as assigned.

Responsibilities include hand delivery of documents to legislators and staff; filing, copying, collating, and assembling documents; handling office supplies with some heavy lifting; and other miscellaneous office duties as needed. Candidates must be able to work flexibly and cooperatively with many interested parties within strict time constraints. The ideal candidate is a motivated, non-partisan individual with a desire to learn about the legislative process.

This is an hourly, part-time position that works in-person approximately 20 hours per week. Benefits include sick time and paid holidays based on the hours worked. The Page hourly salary range is \$18.81-\$33.56 commensurate with relevant experience. A successful candidates pay rate as an entry-level Page is expected to be \$18.81 per hour.
