CHAPTER XIX.—AN ACT to provide for laying out a Territorial Road from the Falls of St. Anthony to the Western boundary of Sibley County.

March 4, 1853.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota: That Emanuel Case, David Gorham and Calvin A. Tuttle, of Hennepin County, are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark a Territorial Road, commencing at the Falls of Saint Anthony, from thence on the most feasible route, via Steven's Mills on Falls Creek, to the western boundary of Sibley county.

Commissioners.

Sec. 2. That the said Commissioners meet at the house of Col. John H. Stevens, in Hennepin County, on the first Monday in May next, at 10 o'clock, A. M., or assoon as practicable thereafter: *Provided, however,* That in the absence of any one of the Commissioners appointed by this Act, the others may have power to supply said vacancy, by appointing another Commissioner; or may, in case a majority of them meet, proceed in discharging their duties, and that it shall be left discretionary with a majority of said Commissioners to adjourn from time to time, as they may deem proper, and the Commissioners when assembled, shall proceed to lay out and mark said road, and the necessary expense incurred for laying out said road shall be paid from the Territorial Treasury; *Provided,* That the whole amount so paid shall not exceed one hundred dollars.
