Feb. 23, 1854.

An Act relative to the County Officers of Wabashaw County.

Abstract to be forwarded.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota, That it shall be the duty of the Register of Deeds of Ramsey County, to forward to the Clerk of the District Court of Wabashaw County, an abstract of the votes polled for County Officers in said County, at the last election, and filed in the office of said Register of Deeds, and said Clerk of the District Court of Wabashaw County, shall, immediately after the receipt of said abstract, issue to each person having received the highest number of votes for any office, a certificate of his election.

May organize.

SEC. 2. The persons receiving certificates in conformity to this act for County Commissioners of said County, shall meet on the first Monday in March, and proceed to organize as provided by law, in the same manner as if the said meeting had been had on the first Monday of January.

Officers may qualify.

SEC. 3. At said meeting of County Commissioners the persons receiving certificates for County Officers, may qualify and assume the duties of their said offices, in the same manner and to the same extent, as if they had received certificates of election and qualified at the time and manner provided by law.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
