

CHAPTER 25.

An Act to amend Chapter 1 of the Revised Statutes and for other purposes.

March 4, 1854.

SECTION

1. Fifteen hundred copies of session laws.

SECTION

2. Three hundred copies of journals.
3. Amendment—Villages.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota, That there shall be printed annually fifteen hundred copies of the Session Laws of this Territory, to be disposed of as provided by law.

Fifteen hundred copies of session laws.

SEC. 2. That the Secretary of the Council and Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives be and they are hereby authorized to cause three hundred copies of the Journal of their respective houses printed, with an appendix, containing all documents laid before their respective houses, and the Journal of the two houses shall hereafter be bound in one volume.

Three hundred copies of journals.

SEC. 3. That Section 1, of Chapter 41, (of the Corporation of Villages) be so amended as to permit fifty persons, if located within a territory of not more than one mile in extent containing a resident population as aforesaid, may be incorporated as a village under the provisions of said chapter forty-one.
