CHAPTER LIV.

A Bill to provide for laying out a Territorial Road from St. Paul to Elliota.

SECTION 1. Commissioners appointed.

- When and where the suid commissioners shall meet.
- 2. When and where the suid commissioners and 3. Commissioners shall deposit map of survey.
- Commissioner can appoint substitute in certain cases. When this act shall take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That David Olmsted of the city of St. Paul, William Commissioners Freeborn of Cannon Falls, Ebenezer S. Collsns of Oronoco, and W. C. Pickett of Carimona, be and the same are hereby appointed commissioners to locate and mark a Territorial Road from the city of St. Paul, by the way of the Falls of Cannon River, Oronoco, Rochester, Curtis and Carimona to Elliota, in Fillmore county.

Commissio n e r e shall meet.

That the said commissioners shall meet at the Merchants Hotel in the city of St. Paul, on the first Monday of April next, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to lay out and mark said Road, by the most direct and practicable route. The expense of laying out the same to be paid by the counties through which said road may pass. commissioners shall decide the proportion and amount of such expense to be paid by each county through which the road may be located, and notify the commissioners of each of said counties of the same.

Map of survey.

SEC. 3. It is hereby made the duty of the above named commissioners to deposit a copy of the map of the survey of said road with the Register of Deeds of each of the counties through which said road passes.

Substitute.

In case either of the commissioners above named shall be unable to perform the duties assigned to him in this act, he shall have the power to appoint a subssitute, and it shall be his duty to notify the other commissioners of the substitution: Provided, that if at the first meeting stipulated in the record section, either of the commissioners shall fail to appear in person or by duly authorized substitute, then his appointment shall be declared cancelled, and the commissioner or commissioners shall have full power to select suitable persons to fill such vacancy or vacancies.

CHAPTER LV.

An Act to amend an act granting to James M. Goodhue and Isaac N. Goodhus the right to establish and maintain a Ferry across the Mississippi river.

- Extension of Ferry Charter granted to James M. Goodhus and Isaac N. Goodhus, under certain provisions.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the term of time granted to James M. Goodhue and Extension of the Isaac N. Goodhue, in the act to which this is amendatory for establishing and maintaining a ferry across the Mi-i-i-ippi river, shall be, and the same is hereby extended for eight additional years to Mrs. Henrietta Mann, her executors, administrators or assigns: *Provided*, That Wm. R. Marshall, J. W. Bass, and H. K. Mann, be and they are hereby authorized to control and manage the operations of said ferry, and to receive the nett proceeds
