

CHAPTER LXIX.

An act to change the time of holding Courts in the County of Ramsey.

SECTION 1. The time of holding the District Court in the Second Judicial District.

2. Of complaints, processes, precepts, &c., to be acted upon by said court at the terms established by the first section of this act.
3. When this act shall take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Minnesota Territory :

SECTION 1. The term of the District Court for the Second Judicial District, within and for the county of Ramsey, now held on the second Monday of March in each year, shall be hereafter held on the first Monday of May annually; and so much of all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

District Court in the second judicial district.

SEC. 2. All complaints, processes, precepts, recognizances and reports of every kind whatever, commenced for, pending in, or returnable to said court, for and within said county, held as aforesaid, shall be returned to, have day in, and be acted upon by said court, at the terms thereof established by the first section of this act.

Complaints for the action of the court.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Act shall take effect.
