A MEMORIAL

To Congress for an appropriation of \$5,000 to extend the Mendota and Big Sioux River road from Mendota to the west bank of the Mississippi River opposite St. Paul.

To the Honorable the Senate and

House of Representatives of the United States in Congress assembled:

The memorial of the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota respectfully represents: That a wagon road extending to the Mendota and Big Sioux River Government road from Mendota to the west bank of the Mississippi river, opposite St. Paul, at a point within or near lot number 8, of section number 6, town 23, range 22; and thence down said river to the point opposite the lower landing in St. Paul, is indispensable to a large number of inhabitants of this Territory; and that the sum of five thousand dollars will be necessary to construct such wagon road.
