

## CHAPTER C.

*An Act to provide for laying-out a Territorial road, from Wabashaw to Austin, Mower County.*

- SECTION 1. Names of Commissioners.  
 2. Time and place of meeting;  
 3. Deposit copy of map.  
 4. Power to appoint substitute.  
 5. When to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That N. K. Brown of the town of Wabashaw, James Bucklin of Rochester, and Alanson B Vaughn of Austin, Mower county, be and the same are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark a Territorial Road from the town of Wabashaw by the way of Greenwood, Rochester, to Austin in Mower county. Commissioners

SEC. 2. That said Commissioners shall meet at the Weston House, in the town of Wabashaw, on the second Monday of April next, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to lay out and mark said road by the most direct and practicable route. The expense of laying out the same to be paid by the counties through which the road may pass. The Commissioners shall decide the proportion and amount of such expense to be paid by each county through which said road may be located, and notify the Commissioners of each of said counties of the same. Time of meeting

SEC. 3. It is hereby made the duty of the above named Commissioners to deposit a copy of the map of the survey of said road with the Register of Deeds of each of the counties through which said road passes. Deposit map

SEC. 4. In case either of the Commissioners above named shall be unable to perform the duties assigned to him in this act, he shall have the power to appoint a substitute, and it shall be his duty to notify the other commissioners of the substitution: Provided, that if at the first meeting stipulated in the second section, that if either of the Commissioners fail to appear in person or duly authorized substitutes, then his appointment shall be declared cancelled, and the commissioner or commissioners shall have full power to select a suitable person to fill such vacancy or vacancies. Appoint substitute

SEC. 5. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage. Take effect
