

CHAPTER CI.

An Act to Provide for laying out a Territorial Road from Wabashaw, by Ide's Settlement, to Farribault, and from thence west, to intersect the Dodd Road, leading to St. Peter.

- SECTION 1. Names of Commissioners.
 2. Time and place of meeting.
 3. Deposit copy of map.
 4. Power to appoint substitute.
 5. When to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

- Commissioners** SECTION 1. That John C. Ide, of Rice county, James Anderson, of Rice county, George Gay, of Wabashaw, and Carrol C. Perkins of Farribault, be, and the same are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark a Territorial Road from Wabashaw, by the way of Ide's settlement, to Farribault, Rice county, and from thence west to intersect the Dodd road leading to Saint Peter.
- Time of meeting.** SEC. 2. That the said Commissioners shall meet at the Weston House, in the town of Wabashaw, on the first Monday of April next, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to mark and lay out said road, by the most direct and practicable route. The expense of laying out the same to be paid by the counties through which said road may pass. The Commissioners shall decide the proportion and amount of such expense to be paid by each county through which the road may be located, and notify the Commissioners of each of said counties of the same.
- Deposit copy of map.** SEC. 3. It is hereby made the duty of the above named Commissioners to deposit a copy of the map of the survey of said road with the Register of Deeds of each of the counties through which said road may pass.
- Appoint substitute.** SEC. 4. In case either of the Commissioners above named, shall be unable to perform the duties assigned to him in this act, he shall have the power to appoint a substitute, and it shall be his duty to notify the other Commissioners of the substitution. Provided, that if at the first meeting, stipulated in the second section, either of the Commissioners shall fail to appear in person or duly authorized substitute, then his appointment shall be declared cancelled, and the Commissioner or Commissioners shall have full power to select suitable persons to fill such vacancy or vacancies.
- To be in force.** SEC. 5. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
