CHAPTER XXII.

A Bill granting to Louis Lacroix the right to establish and maintain a ferry across the Minnesota river, at the town of Little Rapids, in Scott county.

- SECTION 1. Charter granted.
- 2. Keep good boat.
- 3. Rates of ferringe.
- 4. File Bond.
- 5. Remedy for injury.
- 6. Legislature may repeal.
- 7. Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

Names

SECTION 1. That Louis Lacroix, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, shall have the exclusive right and privilege for the period of fifteen years of keeping and maintaining a ferry across the Minnesota river, at the above named point, and no ferry shall be established with one mile of said ferry above or below.

Keep good boat

SEC. 2. Said Louis Lacroix shall at all times keep a safe and good boat or boats, in good repair, sufficient for the accommodation of all persons wishing to cross at said ferry, and shall give prompt and ready attendance for the crossing of passengers, teams, live stock, merchandise, or other articles on all occasions and at all hours, both night and day; but persons crossing at said ferry after nine o'clock at night may be charged double fare as hereinafter prescribed.

Rates

SEC. 3. The rates charged for crossing at the above ferry shall not exceed the following:

For each foot passenger,	- - - - -	10 cents.
For each horse, mare, mule, or ass, with or without rider,	- - - - -	15 "
For each two horse, two ox or two mule team loaded or unloaded,	- - - - -	25 "
For each single horse carriage,	- - - - -	25 "
For each additional cow, horse or ox,	- - - - -	10 "

For each swine or sheep, 2 cents.

All freight, merchandise, or other articles not in teams at the rate of five cents per hundred pounds, and fifty cents per thousand feet of lumber.

SEC. 4. That said Louis Lacroix shall within six months after the passage of this act, file or cause to be filed with the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of the county of Scott, or the county of Carver, a bond to the said Board with two or more sufficient sureties to be approved by said Board in the penal sum of one thousand dollars, conditioned that he will fulfil all the duties that are imposed upon him in the foregoing sections; and in case of a failure so to do, he shall forfeit all the benefits that might have accrued to him from the passage of this act. File bond

SEC. 5. For every neglect in keeping a good and sufficient boat or failure to give due and prompt attendance, the said Louis Lacroix shall forfeit a sum not exceeding twenty dollars, to be recovered by a civil action before any court having competent jurisdiction and shall be further liable in a like action for all damages any person or persons shall sustain by reason of the neglect of the said Louis Lacroix to fulfil any of the duties imposed upon him in this act; and any person who shall sustain injury by the negligence or default of the said Lacroix, or the ferryman in his employ, may have a remedy by an action upon the bond required in this act. Fine for neglect

SEC. 6. The Legislature may repeal, alter or amend this act at any time. Amend

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect from and after its passage. Take effect
