CHAPTER XXIX.

An Act Relating to the distribution of the School Fund in Sibley County.

SECTION 1. Trustees of School District No. 2.

2. When to be in force.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

School Fund.

SECTION 1. That it shall be lawful for the County Commissioners of Sibley county to pay to the Trustees of school district No 2, in said county, the proportion of the School Fund of said county, to which said district would have been entitled had a school been kept in said district for the full term of three months during the past year, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

To be in force.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
