CHAPTER VI.

An Act prescribing the manner in which Corporations may convey Real Estate.

Section 1. May convey the same by an agent appointed by vote.

2. Copy of such vote to be recorded.

Be it enacted by the Legislatice Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

Section 1. Every public or private Corporation authorized to hold convey by an Real Estate, may convey the same by an agent appointed by vote for that

purpose.

SEC. 2. Whenever the corporators, members, stockholders, trustees or Record of apdirectors of any Corporation, shall, by a vote or resolution, appoint an agent to convey the real estate of such Corporation, a copy of such vote or resolution certified by the Clerk or Secretary of such Corporation, may be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of the county in which the real estate to which such vote or resolution relates, may be situated. And such vote or resolution, when so certified, and the record thereof when so recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, or a transcript of such record duly certified, may be used in evidence in the same manner and with like effect as a conveyance recorded in such county.
