

ble, and proceed to lay out and mark said road by the most direct and feasible route. The expense of laying out the same be paid by the different counties through which said road may pass. The Commissioners shall decide the amount each county shall pay of such expenses, and notify the Commissioners of each county of the same.

Sec. 3. It is hereby made the duty of the said Commissioners to make out a full plat of the said road and file a copy of the same in the office of the County Commissioners or Register of Deeds of the different counties which said road may pass through. Duty of Commissioners.

Sec. 4. That the Commissioners are hereby empowered to employ the services of a surveyor and other persons necessary for the locating the said road. Employ surveyors.

Sec. 5. In case of inability on the part of either of the above named Commissioners to act in the location of said road, he shall have the power to appoint a substitute, and it shall be his duty to notify the other Commissioners; Provided, That if at the first meeting stipulated above, either of the Commissioners shall fail to appear, in person, then it shall be the duty of the other Commissioner or Commissioners to appoint suitable persons to fill such vacancy. Appoint substitutes.

Sec. 6. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage. To be in force.

CHAPTER LXXXIII.

An Act to provide for the laying out a Territorial Road from Red Wing to Henderson.

- SECTION 1. Names of Commissioners.
2. How to proceed.
3. Map to be deposited with Register of Deeds.
4. Substitute may be appointed.
5. When to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That William Freeborn, Wilson Paxton, and Joseph R. Brown are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark a Territorial Road from Red Wing, in Goodhue County, by the way of the Falls of Cannon River, to Henderson, in Sibley County. Names.

How to proceed SEC. 2. That the said Commissioners, or a majority of them, shall meet at Red Wing, on the first Monday of April next, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to lay out and mark said Road, by the most direct and practicable route, following the Mendota and Wabashaw Road to some point between Red Wing, and the Cannon River. Said road when laid out and located, shall in connection with the Territorial Road from Henderson to Fort Ridgely, constitute and be known as the Territorial Road from Red Wing to Fort Ridgely.

Map to be deposited with Register of Deeds SEC. 3. It is hereby made the duty of the above named Commissioners, to deposit a copy of the map of the survey of said road, with the Register of Deeds of each of the counties through which said road passes.

Substitute may be appointed SEC. 4. In case either of the Commissioners above named shall be unable to perform the duties assigned him in this act, he shall have the power to appoint a substitute, and it shall be his duty to notify the other Commissioners of the substitution. Provided, That if at the first meeting stipulated in the second section, either of the Commissioners shall fail to appear either in person or by duly authorized substitute, then his appointment shall be declared cancelled, and the commissioner or commissioners shall have full power to select suitable persons to fill such vacancy or vacancies.

To be in force. SEC. 5. This act to be in force from and after its passage.

same SECTION 1. That Pierre Bottineau, S. B. Lowry and Albert Sargent, be and the same are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark a Territorial Road from the town of St. Cloud by the way of the mouth of the Sioux River to Pembina.
