Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota :

SECTION I. That S. H. Abbott, W. W. Sweeney, Wm. Colville, Jr., are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark a Territorial Road from Red Wing, in Goodhue county, by the way of Franklin, Owatonia and Wilton in Steele county, to or near Forks of Blue Earth River, near the House of Moses Sailor, in Farribault county.

SEC. 2. That the said Commissioners, or a majority of them, shall meet at Red Wing, on the first Monday of April next or as soon thereafter as practicable and proceed to lay out and mark said road by the

SEC. 3. It is hereby made the duty of the above named Commissioners to deposit a copy of the map of the survey of said road with the Register of Deeds of each of the counties through which said road passes. SEC. 4. In case either of the Commissioners above named shall be unable to perform the duties assigned him in this act, he shall have the power to appoint a substitute, and it shall be his duty to notify the other

Provided, that if at the first meeting, stipulated in the second section, either of the Commissioners shall fail to appear either in person or by, duly authorized substitute then his appointment shall be declared cancelled, and the Commissioner or Commissioners shall have full power to select suitable persons to fill such vacancy or vacancies.
