## CHAPTER XXVII.

*An Act to Extend the time for the Collection of Taxes in Olmsted County, M. T.*

*Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the time for the collection of Taxes in Olmsted County, for the year 1856, be, and the same is hereby extended to the first Monday of July, 1857.

SEC. 2. The collector of Taxes in said county shall make his returns to the proper authorities, on the 2nd Monday of July, 1857.

SEC. 3. The provisions of this act shall only apply to taxes already assessed and due in said county.
