CHAPTER LXV.

An Act to amend an Act entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Saint Paul Gas Light Company."

SECTION 1 Time of Laying Pipes Extended.
2 Amendments to Section 11 of original charter.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the time mentioned and specified in the act "Incorporating the St. Paul Gas Light Company," approved March 1, 1856, for constructing and laying "at least one and a half miles of main pipe," and furnishing "gas and fixtures to the city and citizens of St. Paul," shall be extended, and the same is hereby extended, to the first day of December, A. D. 1857.

Sec. 2. That section eleven of said charter, an act of Incorporation, be and the same is hereby amended by inserting in line fourteen of said section eleven, the word "twenty," after the word "and" and before the word "years" in the blank, as appears in the printed edition of the Session Laws

for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six.
