## CHAPTER XI.

### *An Act to Incorporate the Town of Traverse des Sioux.*

- SECTION 1 Boundaries of the Town.  
2 Town Council and other officers.  
3 The first Town Council—Names.  
4 Corporation Powers.

*Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That so much land as is contained in the west half and south east quarter of north east quarter, and lots numbers one and two; and south half of north west quarter of section number nine, and lot number nine, of section number four, in township number one hundred and ten, north of range number twenty-six west, containing two hundred and forty acres, be, and the same is hereby created a town corporate by the name of Traverse des Sioux, and shall have and enjoy all the powers, privileges and responsibilities usually enjoyed by municipal corporations.

SEC. 2. That for the good order and government of said town, it shall be lawful and there shall be established a President, Secretary, and three Trustees, who shall constitute the Town Council of said town, any three of whom shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

SEC. 3. Madison Sweetzer, as President; Andrew J. Myrick as Secretary, and Duncan Kennedy, Thomas Corwin and Jas. H. McDougall, Trustees, shall be known and are hereby constituted the Town Council of said town, who shall hold their offices for one year and until their successors shall be elected and qualified.

SEC. 4. The President and Trustees of said town are hereby created a body politic and corporate, with perpetual succession to be known and designated by the name of the town of Traverse des Sioux, and shall possess all the rights and be subject to all the liabilities usually belonging to municipal corporations.
