

CHAPTER XVI.

A Bill for an Act to Define the Boundaries between the Counties of Rice and Dakota.

SECTION 1 Defines the Boundaries between Rice and Dakota Counties.
 2 Take effect.

SECTION 1. That the southern tier of sections in townships one hundred and twelve, north of ranges nineteen and twenty west, be, and the same are hereby annexed to, and shall hereafter constitute a part of the County of Rice; and that all of said township one hundred and twelve, north of range nineteen west, not already included in the county of Dakota, be, and the same is hereby annexed to, and shall hereafter constitute a part of the County of Dakota; and that said portions of townships so annexed, shall form a part of the representative district of the county to which they are annexed respectively. Boundary line defined

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
