

CHAPTER XXXIII.

A Bill for an Act to extend the corporate limits of the Town of Chatfield.

SECTION 1 Provides for the extension of the Boundary Line.
2 Act to take effect upon passage.

Corporate limits SECTION 1. The corporate limits, powers, obligations and privileges of the town of Chatfield in the Counties of Fillmore and Olmsted, are hereby extended so as to include the north half, $\frac{1}{2}$, of Section six, 6; the north half of the south-east quarter of section six, 6; the north-west quarter of section five, the north half of the south-west quarter of section five, the west half of the north-east quarter of section five, the north-west quarter of the south-east quarter, and the south-west quarter of the north-east quarter of section five in Township No. one hundred and four, range No. eleven; also the south half of section thirty-one, in township one hundred and five, range eleven, or such portions of the same as may not be included in the act incorporating said town of Chatfield, approved March 6, A. D. 1857.

Take effect SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
