

CHAPTER XLIII.

A Bill to amend Session Law: of 1854.

SECTION 1 Amends Section 12, Chapter 36, of Session Laws of 1854.
 2 Takes effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

SEC. 1. That Section twelve of Chapter thirty-six of the Session Laws of the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four be, and the same is hereby, amended so as to read as follows :

Amendment

SEC. 12. The Board of Trustees may meet on their own adjournment, any five of whom shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and the President, with the concurrence of two Trustees, or any four Trustees, may call special meetings of the Board, by giving notice to the members thereof, in writing or otherwise, at least ten days before the time of such meeting, and any Trustee may be removed for a neglect of duty more than one year.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
