CHAPTER LXV.

A Bill to Change the Name of the Root River Valley and Southern Minnesota Railroad Company.

- SECTION 1 Name Changed to Southern Minnesota Railroad Company.
2 Section two of the Original Act amended.
3 Act to take effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The corporate name of the Root River Valley and Southern Minnesota Railroad Company shall hereafter be the Southern Minnesota Railroad Company, and by that name shall be known and called in all its corporate acts and dealings.

SEC. 2. That Sec. 2 of An Act to Incorporate the Root River Valley and Southern Minnesota Railroad Company, Approved March 2d, 1855, be amended by striking out the words "Eagle Bluff's in Winona County," and insert in lieu thereof the words "La Crescent in Houston County." Amendments

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXVI.

A Bill to Incorporate the Dodge County Building and Library Association.

- SECTION 1 Incorporation and Powers.
 2 Objects of Incorporation.
 3 Power to enjoy real and personal Property.
 4 Elect officers.
 5 Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota :

Power of In-
corporators

SECTION 1. That Peter Mantor, Frank Mantor, J. H. Sheber, G. W. Slocum, and G. P. Bancroft, and all others that may associate with them, are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of the Dodge County Building and Library Association, and by that name they and their successors shall have the power to make and use a common seal and the same to alter at pleasure, to contract, and be contracted with, sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded with, answer and be answered unto in all courts having competent jurisdiction, and have all the powers and privileges necessary to carry out the objects of the association and incorporation.

Objects of As-
sociation

SEC. 2. The objects of said corporation shall be to establish a Building Association and also to establish a Public Library in the Town of Mantorville.

SEC. 3. The said corporation are hereby invested with power and authority to acquire, hold, possess, use, occupy, and
