

CHAPTER LXIX.

An Act to incorporate the Town of Paynesville.

SECTION 1 Boundaries of the Town.
2 First Officers named.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

Boundaries SECTION 1. That the north half of Section seventeen, town one hundred and twenty-two, range thirty-two, west, be, and the same is hereby created a town corporate and politic, by the name and style of Paynesville, subject to all the rights and privileges of similar town corporations in the Territory of Minnesota.

First Officers SEC. 2. That James Phillips, President, Edwin E. Paynes, Recorder, and Cyrus E. Snyder, Sam'l Parks and John McCormick, Trustees, are hereby appointed the President, Recorder and Trustees of said Town for one year, and until their successors shall be chosen.
