The said Directors shall have power to make, ordain, or establish all such By-Laws, rules and regulations, as they may deem expedient or necessary for the government of the Company, and for the well ordering, regulating and securing their business affairs, and such By-Laws, rules and regulations shall have the force and effect of law; Provided, The same be not inconsistent with, or repugnant to the laws of the United States or of the Territory of Minnesota.

Sec. 5. The Executive officer of this Company, or an officer having full power to act in all respects in lieu of said Executive offiofficer; together with a financial officer of said corporation, shall reside within the limits of the Territory or future State

of Minnesota.

Sec. 6. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

That the acts of the county officers of the counties of Benton, Steams and Morrison, for the year 1856, are hereby ratified and confirmed, and that the action of said officers shall be valid and binding upon any and all persons whomsoever, both in law and equity; any non-compliance with the statutory details in the election of said officers-notwithstanding.

SECTION 1 Assignment of Justices to the several Districts.

3 Act to take effect on its passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

Section 1. Hon. Wm. H. Welch is hereby assigned to and declared to be Justice in and for the first Judicial District. Hon. R. R. Nelson is hereby assigned to the Second Judicial District, and the Hon. John Pettit, or such person as may hereafter be appointed associate Justice of the Territory of Minnesota, is hereby assigned to the Third Judicial District.
