## CHAPTER LXXVIII.

An Act to Legalize the Records of certain Towns on the North Shore of Lake Superior.

SECTION 1 Legalizing Records of Town sites in Lake county.

Beit maded by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

Section 1. That all town sites heretofore laid out and platted in the county of Lake, and recorded in the office of Legalizing Recthe Register of Deeds of St. Louis county, it being the nearest office of record, to said county of Lake, shall not be invalidated in consequence of such record not being placed upon the books of Benton county.
