Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

That sections Nos. one (1,) two (2,) three (3,) four (4,) five (5,) and six (6,) in each of townships No. one hundred and four (104,) north of ranges No. fourteen (14,)Description of Boundaries and fifteen (15,) are hereby detached from the county of Mower and attached to the county of Olmsted.
