

CHAPTER XCII.

An Act additional to An Act prescribing Rules and Regulations for the Execution of the Trust arising under the Act of Congress, entitled An Act for the relief of Citizens of Towns upon lands of the United States, under certain circumstances, Approved March 3d, 1855.

SECTION 1 Judges authorized to execute all Trusts while acting as such.
2 Take effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. A. J. Chatfield and Moses Sherburne, former Judges of this Territory, are hereby authorized and empowered to discharge and execute all trusts which they severally assumed, while acting as Judges, by virtue of the above mentioned acts, in all respects, in the same manner and subject to the same duties and requirements as they might and would be if still holding their said offices.

Executes all trusts

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
