CHAPTER XXVIII.

An Act to extend the time for taking the Assessments in this State.

SECTION 1. Assessments for 1838 extended to August 18.
2. Act takes effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Time of assessment extended Section 1. That the assessments to be made by the Assessors, as provided for in an Act providing for Township Organizations, shall be extended to the twentieth day of August next, instead of the time now specified and provided.
