CHAPTER XLII.

An Act to Legalize Certain Conveyances heretofore made.

Faction 1. Conveyances with one subscribing witness made legal.

2. Act takes effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That all conveyances of real estate heretofore made within the limits of this State, properly sealed and acconverances legal knowledged with one subscribing witness thereto, shall be legal and valid to all intents and purposes.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect from and after its pas-

sage.

CHAPTER XLIII.

An Act to encourage Emigration.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for the preparing of a number of ensays on the climate, soit and resources of Minnesota.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of one hundred dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, be paid to Joseph A. Whee-
