

## CHAPTER XCVIII.

*An Act making Certain Appropriations.*

SECTION 1. Appropriation to pay expenses of transporting coin from New York to St. Paul, \$1125.

2. Payment of Interest on Territorial Bonds, \$1220.

3. Payment of expenses of Legislature, and mileage in contested election case; \$45,596.00.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. The sum of one thousand one hundred and twenty-five dollars, (\$1125,) or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for the payment of Express charges which may be incurred in the transportation of Coin to St. Paul, in case of the negotiation of the loan to the State by Act of March 13, 1858.

Expenses of transporting coin to St Paul

SEC. 2. The sum of one thousand two hundred and twenty dollars, (\$1220,) or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to pay the principal and interest due on Territorial bonds, issued by Act of May 23, 1857.

Interest on territorial bonds

SEC. 3. That the sum of forty-six thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, or so much thereof as may be necessary, out of any money remaining in the Treasury, for the payment of the per diem, postage, and stationery, of the members and officers of the present adjourned Session of the Legislature, to be computed from the second day of June, 1858, and the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the same upon presentation to him of the Certificate properly signed and attested by the officers of the Senate or House of Representatives. That the sum of ninety-six dollars is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for mileage and per diem of Patrick Fitzsimmons, as witness in the contested election of Kingsley and Dunham, for which the Clerk's Certificate has been issued.

Expenses of Legislature

SEC. 4. *This Act shall effect from and after its passage.*
