*A Memorial to Congress for the Establishment of a Mail Route from Winona [Chatfield] to Winnebago City, in Farriault County.*

*To the Honorable the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States in Congress assembled :*

The Memorial of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota respectfully sheweth that the interest and convenience of the inhabitants of the southern tier of Counties of this State requires the establishment of a Mail Route from Chatfield in the County of Fillmore, by the way of High Forest, Madison, Geneva, and Freeborn, to Winnebago City, in the County of Farriault. Your memorialists, therefore request your Honorable Bodies to establish a post route between the above mentioned points, touching at the points aforesaid, and authorize the mail to be carried on said route twice a week.
