Comfort, are hereby appointed Trustees, which said Board of Trustees shall elect a Secretary, and the said President, Trustees and Secretary, shall constitute the Council of said town, and shall hold their office until their successors are elected and qualified.

SEC. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This Act shall be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER CXXI.

An Act to amend an Act entitled "An Act to Incorporate certain Towns."

SECTION 1. Amendment to Chapter 18, Extra Session Laws, Section 12, providing Town officers, and for a Town election.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

That Section 12 of said Act be amended so as to read as follows: That so much land as is contained in the town site of Manannah, Meeker county, viz: township 121, range 31 and 32, and sections 25 and 30, be and the same is hereby created a town corporate and politic by the name of Manannah.
