## CHAPTER CXL.

## An Act in relation to the Towns of Nininger, Louisville, Glencos and Young America.

## Emonton 1. Towns anthorized to make loans to bnide Nininger, St. Petor. and Western R. $\mathbf{R}$. <br> 2. To be made only apon a majority voto of the property holders <br> 3. Aot takes effect on passego.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
Segrion 1. That the citizens of either of the following towns, viz: Nininger, in Dakota county, Louisville, in Scott coanty, Young America, in Carver county, and Glencoe, in Towns anthosMcLeod connty, be and tho same are hereby empowered, at loans to bulld any public meeting called for that purpose, by a majority Ninlnger, st of those present, to anthorize the Town Council of their Weatern $\mathbf{B} \mathbf{R}$ respective towns, by such means as may be pointed out by the said meeting, aither by the levying of a tax or otherwise, to assist in the building of the Niningor, St. Peter and Western Railroad, to such extent as the said meeting may direct.

Sec. 2. The action of the said meeting shall not be valid unless those who compose it constitute a majority of the Tobe made onresident property-holders of said town, so holding said meet- yo pron a man ing, nor unless public notice of the meeting and the object the property thereof is given by posting up a written or printed notice holders thereof, in at least three of the most public places in said town, twenty days before the time of such meeting, and by publishing a copy thercof in the newspapers of said town or of the locality nearest thereto at least twice before said meeting.

Sac. 3. This Act shall take effect from and after its pasasge.
