

CHAPTER CXLIV.

An Act authorizing the Register of Deeds of Olmsted county, to copy from the Records of Mower County.

- SECTION 1. Authority to Register of Deeds of Olmsted County to copy record from Mower County.
2. Fees for copying records.
 3. Expenses to be paid by County of Olmsted.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the Register of Deeds of the county of Olmsted, is hereby empowered and authorized to copy from the Register of Deeds office in the county of Mower, all warrants or quit-claim deeds, mortgages, bonds, powers of attorney, bills of sale, or any instruments of agreement, which have been recorded in the county of Mower, or that belongs, pertains or relates to property, real or personal, which is within the limits of the county of Olmsted.

SEC. 2. The Register of Deeds shall receive for such services the same fees as is allowed to clerks of election, making election returns as traveling fees, and the same for copying the instruments named in Section 1, as is allowed under the law for recording the same.

SEC. 3. The costs of such copying and traveling fees shall be paid out of the treasury of the county of Olmsted. The County Supervisors, first approving of the same, shall order it paid.

SEC. 4. This Act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
