

CHAPTER OLIII.

An Act to legalize the survey of South Wabashaw, in Wabashaw county.

SECTION 1. Survey and plat of South Wabashaw and City of Wabashaw confirmed.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. The survey and plot of South Wabashaw, and city of Wabashaw, in the county of Wabashaw, as surveyed and platted by H. J. Hilbert, in September, A. D. 1855, ^{confirmed} and embracing the following described lands, to wit: The west half of the north-west quarter of section thirty-three, and the north-east quarter of section thirty-two, in town one hundred and eleven, range ten, is hereby declared to be the legal survey and plat of said town of South Wabashaw.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
