## An Act in relation to a Territorial Road from Smithtoron to Shakopee.

SECTION 1. Repeal of Chapter 85 of laws of 1856, locating a State Road.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the Territorial Road laid out and estab-Repeal of chap lished from Smithtown, on Minnetonka Lake, in Carver county, so of laws of '56 locating a state road to Shakopee, in Scott County, be and the same is hereby vacated and discontinued; and that Section 41 of the Act entitled An Act to provide for laying out certain Territorial Roads in the Territory of Minnesota, and other purposes, approved March 1st, 1856, which authorizes the location of said road, is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CLX.

An Act in regard to the Road from Minncapolis to Greenwood.

SECTION 1. Road from Minneapolis to Greenwood declared a State Road. 2. Plat of Road when to be filed with Register of Deeda.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

## OHAPTER OLXI.

An Act authorizing the Register of Deeds of Olmsted County, to copy from the Records of Fillmore County.

SECTION 1. Register of Olmsted County anthorized to copy records from Fillmore County.

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Pees for copying.
Costs thereof to be paid by Olmsted County.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the Register of Deeds of Olmsted county, is hereby authorized to copy from the office of the Register Register of of Deeds in Fillmore county, all deeds, mortgages, bonds, Olmsted com-powers of attorney, or other instruments which have been ords from Fillrecorded in Fillmore county, that relate to the real estate, more county situated in Olmsted county.

SEC. 2. The Register shall receive for such services, such Fees for copyfees as are allowed by law for recording deeds, and othering instruments in writing, and for traveling fees, the same per mile as is allowed to clerks of election in making election returns.
