*An Act authorizing the Register of Deeds of Olmsted
County, to copy from the Records of Fillmore County.*

SECTION 1. Register of Olmsted County authorized to copy records from
Fillmore County.

2. Fees for copying.

3. Costs thereof to be paid by Olmsted County.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the Register of Deeds of Olmsted county,
is hereby authorized to copy from the office of the Register Register of
of Deeds in Fillmore county, all deeds, mortgages, bonds, ty to copy rec-
powers of attorney, or other instruments which have been ords from Fill-
recorded in Fillmore county, that relate to the real estate, more county
situated in Olmsted county.

Sec. 2. The Register shall receive for such services, such Fees for copy-
fees as are allowed by law for recording deeds, and other ing
instruments in writing, and for traveling fees, the same per
mile as is allowed to clerks of election in making election
returns.

Costs how paid SEC. 3. The cost of such copying, and the traveling fees shall be paid out of the treasury of Olmsted county, the Board of Supervisors first approving the same.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

An Act to confirm the alteration of the survey and plat of the Town of Belle Plaine.

SECTION 1. Alteration in survey and plat of Town confirmed.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
