

## CHAPTER XVIII.

*An Act to locate a State Road from Monticello to Forest City.*

- ENACTED** 1. Board of Commissioners.  
 2. Meeting of Board—power to appoint substitute.  
 3. Make out and deposit draft of location.  
 4. Each county to pay expenses.  
 5. Per diem of Commissioners, &c.  
 6. Take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

**SECTION 1.** That Philip Smith, Joseph Rackliff and John Wigle are hereby appointed Commissioners to mark out and locate a State Road, commencing at Monticello, thence by way of Geneva and Albion, direct to Forest City.

**SEC. 2.** The said Commissioners shall meet at Monticello on the eighth day of March, A. D. 1858, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed on them by the provisions of this Act, provided however, that in the absence of any one of said Commissioners appointed by this Act, the others may have power to supply said vacancy by appointing another Commissioner, or may in case a majority of them meet, proceed to discharge their duties.

**SEC. 3.** That said Commissioners shall make out a fair and accurate draft of the location of said road; one copy whereof shall be deposited in the office of the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Wright County, and one in the office of the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Meeker County.

**SEC. 4.** That each county, through which said road shall pass, shall pay the expenses incurred in the location of the same, in proportion to the length of said road in each county respectively.

**SEC. 5.** That said Commissioners shall be allowed the sum of three dollars per day for the time necessarily occupied in the location of said road, and they are hereby empowered to employ one Surveyor at five dollars per day, two Chainmen and one Axeman at a sum not exceeding two dollars per day each.

**SEC. 6.** This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER XIX.

*An Act to lay out and establish a State Road from a point opposite Shakopee, to Dayton in Hennepin County.*

- SECTION 1. Board of Commissioners—duties.  
2. Meeting of Commissioners.  
3. Deposit map of said road.  
4. Power to appoint substitute.  
5. Expense to be paid by the several counties.  
6. Take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That James Sharver, Jr. Franklin Cook and Sterritt Anderson be and are hereby appointed commission-Commissioners  
ers to lay out, make and establish a State road,—commencing  
at a point oppsite the present city of Shakopee: running  
thence to the Narrows of Minnetonka, at or near the resi-  
dence of James Sharver, Jr: thence, on the most feasible route,  
to Dayton in Hennepin County.

SEC. 2. The said commissioners or a majority of them  
shall meet at the office of Franklin Cook, in Hennepin County, Meeting  
on the first Monday in April next, and proceed to survey and  
establish said road according to the provisions of section  
first of this act.

SEC. 3. It is hereby made the duty of the above-named  
commissioners to deposit a copy of the map of said road with Deposit map  
the Register of Deeds of Hennepin County.

SEC. 4. If either of the above-named commissioners shall  
be unable to perform the duties assigned to him, it shall be the Substitute  
duty of the other commissioners to appoint substitutes in  
their stead.
