CHAPTER CLXXXIII.

An Act to amend An Act to provide for the Construction of the Canon Falls and St. Paul Road, approved March 20, 1858.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Section three, of Chapter twenty-sixth, relating to payment of expenses.
1. Repeal of a portion of Section four, of the same Chapter, concerning the issuing of County Orders.
 2. Location and construction of Road, to be in accordance with existing laws.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That Section three (3), of said Act is so amended that said Section shall read as follows, to wit: Amendment to sec 3 chap 26
 " That each county through which said road shall pass shall pay the expenses incurred in locating and constructing that portion of said road in each county respectively."

SEC. 2. That so much of Section four (4), of said Act as

authorizes said Road Commissioners to issue orders upon the Treasurers of each of said counties for the amount of expenses incurred in locating and constructing said road, is hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. That said road, from and after the passage of this Act, shall be located, constructed and repaired in the same manner as by law is provided for locating, opening and constructing State roads in this State.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CLXXXIV.

An Act to amend an Act entitled "An Act to provide for the laying out of certain Territorial Roads in the State [Territory] of Minnesota," approved February 27th, 1855.

SECTION I. Amendment to Section thirty, Chapter thirteen, Session Laws 1855, concerning the re-location of a Territorial Road.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION I. That Section thirty of said Act is hereby amended so as to read: "That H. J. Tattersall, Wm. Scoolcraft, and Wm. Carson, are hereby appointed Commissioners to re-locate and establish such portion of the territorial road from a point nearly opposite La Crosse to Mankato, as lies between section one, town one hundred and four, range fourteen, and section one, town one hundred and five, range fifteen, in the county of Olmsted.
