

CHAPTER OXOVI.

An Act to locate and establish a State Road from Taylor's Falls to Sauk Rapids.

- SECTION 1.** Appointment of Commissioners to lay out State Road from Taylor's Falls to Sauk Rapids.
1. Meeting of Commissioners.
 2. Draft and location of Road to be deposited with Board of County Supervisors.
 4. Power of Commissioners to appoint substitutes.
 5. Expenses of location paid by the counties through which the Road passes.
 6. Per diem of Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That Ephraim C. Ingalls, William W. Payne, ^{Appointment} and Albert Damon, be and are hereby appointed, ^{of commissioners} Commissioners to lay out, mark and establish a State Road, ^{com-}encing at Taylor's Falls, thence running on the county road to where said county road terminates on the bank of Sunrise River in town thirty-five (35), range twenty (20), thence via Washington, in Olusago county, Cambridge, in Isanti county, Princeton, in Monroe county, to Sauk Rapids, in Benton county, said road to be located on the most direct and feasible route from town to town as designated in this Section.

SEC. 2. The commissioners shall meet at such place and ^{Meeting of} time as the majority may agree upon, by giving ten days ^{commissioners} notice thereof to the other commissioners.

SEC. 3. The commissioners shall proceed to survey and ^{Draft of road to} establish said road according to Section one (1) of this Act, ^{be deposited} and shall complete the same, and file a plat of said road in the office of the Register of Deeds of the organized counties through which the road is located, within one year from the passage of this Act. The said plat, before being filed as aforesaid, shall be signed by at least two of the said commissioners, whose certificate shall be legal evidence of the establishment of said road.

SEC. 4. If either of said commissioners shall fail to, or be ^{Power to ap-} unable to perform the duties assigned, it shall be the duty of ^{point sub-} the other commissioners to appoint substitutes in their ^{stitutes} stead.

SEC. 5. The expense incurred in the survey and location ^{Expenses how} of said road, shall be paid by the counties through which the ^{paid} same may pass. *Provided,* That each county shall pay the expense incurred within its own limits.

SEC. 6. The commissioners shall be paid two dollars per ^{Per diem}

day, for the actual service performed in surveying and establishing said road.

CHAPTER OXOVII

An Act to legalize the qualifications of Officers and Ministers of McLeod County.

SECTION 1. Acts of County Officers and Ministers of McLeod county legalized.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Acts of county officers and ministers legalized

SECTION 1. That the official acts of said county and precinct officers, elected or appointed since the organization of the county, and also of Ministers or Clergymen, done, performed, or exercised in accordance with the law made and provided for the regulation and action of officers, and of such Ministers or Clergymen, shall be valid and binding upon all persons whomsoever both in law and equity, any non-compliance with the statutory details in the qualification of said officers or said Ministers or Clergymen notwithstanding.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.
