

CHAPTER CCI.

An Act to locate a State Road from St. Cloud to Olean.

- SECTION 1.** Commissioners named to lay out road.
 2. Duties of the Commissioners.
 3. Absence of Commissioners, others to be appointed.
 4. Expenses to be paid by counties through which the road passes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Phillip Beaupry, Winslow Libby and Wm. McNeal, are hereby appointed Commissioners to lay out and establish a State Road, commencing at St. Cloud, thence by the most direct and feasible route by way of Winnebago, to Olean.

SEC. 2. The Commissioners shall meet at the Winnebago House, in Winnebago, on or before the first Tuesday in September next, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to lay out and establish said road, according to the provisions of Section one of this Act, and shall complete the same and file a plat of said road in the office of the Clerk of the Board of County Supervisors.

SEC. 3. If either of the above named Commissioners shall be unable to perform the duties assigned them, it shall be the duty of the other Commissioners to appoint others in their stead.

SEC. 4. The expenses incurred in the survey and location of said road, shall be paid by the counties through which said road may pass.

SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
