## CHAPTER COXXVIIL

An Act to amend An Act to amend Chapter Eighty of the Session Lance of the Territory of Minnesota, passed at the Eatra Session of the Legislative Assembly, held August [April] 27th, 1867.

Exercer 1. Amendment to the not providing for the opening of Fort St., [See Chapter 111.)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesoto:

Lapter 111

SECTION 1. Section Fourteen of Chapter Eighty of the Amendment to Session Laws passed at the extra session held in the year 1857, is hereby amended so as to read as follows, viz: The fees of the Commissioners appointed under this Act, shall be two dollars a day for each Commissioner. They shall have power to employ a surveyor, at the price of five dollars a day or less, and make all surveys that may be necessary in the performance of their duties. All accounts for services rendered or expenses incurred under the provisions of this Act, shall be certified by the Secretary of said Commissioners. and the same as well as the fees of said Commissioners, certified as aforesaid, shall be paid by the Treasurer of eaid county upon orders drawn by said Board of County Commissioners. No error or informality in proceedings under this Act, not affecting the substantial right of parties shall render such proceedings invalid, or vitiate any assessment or tax levied under said Act. The said Commissioners shall cause affidavits of the publication of all notices herein required to be published, to be made by the publisher of the newspaper in which the same shall have been or may be published, or by some person in his office acquainted with the facts, and the same may be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of said county, and shall be evidence of the facts therein contained. The said District Judge may by order, to be filed and recorded in the office of said Register of Deeds, fill any vacancy in the number of such Commissioners, occasigned by the death, resignation or refusal to act of any such Commissioners.

> Sec 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

And after crossing the Big Cottonwood, to intersect the road from New Ulm to Nobles Wagon Road, at the middle line of Section thirty-four (84), township one hundred and ten (110), range thirty-one (81), at the same point that the road from New Ulm intersects said line.
