2. Repeal of State Road from Township 22, Hange 23, Hanney County, to Williams' Ferry.

3. Change in location do., from Handerson to Mobies' Wagon Road.

4. Change in location &c., from Mankato to Nobles' Wagen Road. 5. Relocation of road from Mankato to Brownsville.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SEC. 8. That Section one of said Act is hereby amended by striking out the name of J. B. Calkins, and inserting the change in loss name of Fred. Rehfeld. And after the road leaves New Ulm, tion at or near the house of John Dans, and running to the middle line of section thirty-four (84), township one hundred and ten (110), range thirty-one, at a convenient point, thence west on said line as far as practicable.

SEC. 4. That Section seventy-three of said Act is hereby amended by striking out the name of J. B. Calkins, and inserting the name of Fred. Rehfeld. And after crossing the Big Cottonwood, to intersect the road from New Ulm to Nobles Wagon Road, at the middle line of Section thirty-four (84), township one hundred and ten (110), range thirty-one (81), at the same point that the road from New Ulm intersects said line.

SEC. 5. That Section thirty-two (82) of said Act is hereby Change in loca. amended as follows: Commencing at Crystal Lake City, ten
