## An"Act to locate a State Road from Brownsville, in Houston County, to Winnebago City, in Faribault Country.

ς:

Board of Commissioners. **BECTION 1.** 

Meeting of Commissioners-appoint substitutes. 2.

Deposit Draft of Location. 8.

Each county to pay expenses. Commissioners per diem-surveyors &c. 5.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SEC. 1. That Edward Mackintire, M. J. Foster and John Commissioners Patterson, be, and the same are hereby appointed Commissioners, to locate and mark out a State Road, commencing at Brownsville, in the county of Houston, from thence by way of Sheldon, Dedham, Preston, Carimona, Forrestville, Spring Valley, Frankfort, Austin, Sumner, and Albert Lea, to Winnebago City, in the county of Faribault. SEC. 2. That said Commissioners shall meet at Browns.

Meeting-sn ville, on or before the first Monday in September, A. D. 1858, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed upon vacancy] them by the provisions of this act: Provided, however, That in the absence of any one of the said Commissioners appointed by this act, the others may have power to supply the vacancy, by appointing another Commissioner, or may, in case a majority of them meet, proceed to discharge their duties.

SEC. 3. That said Commissioners shall make out a fair and accurate draft of the location of said road, one copy whereof shall be deposited in the office of the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of the respective counties through which said road may pass.

SEC. 4. That each county through which said road shall Expenses pass, shall pay the expenses incurred in the location of the how paid same, in proportion to the length of said road in each county respectively.

SEC. 5. That said Commissioners shall be allowed the Per diem sum of three dollars per day for the time necessarily occupied in the location of said road; and they are hereby empowered to employ one surveyor, at three dollars per day, two chainmen and one axeman at a sum not exceeding one dollar and fifty cents per day.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect from and after its Take effect passage.
