## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That William W. Knapp, Theophilus Brown, and A. M. Burnham, be and are hereby appointed Commis-Commissioners sioners to survey and locate a State Road from Blue Earth City, in Faribault county, via Walnut Lake, (so called,) Albert Lea, to Shell Rock City, in Freeborn county.

SEC. 2 Said Commissioners shall meet at the office of J. A. Keister, Esq., in Blue Earth City, on the first Monday of May, A. D. 1858, or as soon thereafter as is practicable, and proceed to lay out and mark said Road by the most feasible
