

CHAPTER XLV.

An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Sibley County to issue and sell Bonds for the purpose of erecting County Buildings for said County.

- SECTION 1. Authorizes Bonds to be issued for erection of County Buildings.
 2. Tax to be levied for payment of interest and principal.
 3. Act takes effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Bonds to be issued for the erection of county buildings
 SECTION 1. The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Sibley, in the State of Minnesota, are hereby authorized to issue Bonds, not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of ten thousand dollars, at such times and in such manner, and upon such terms and conditions as the said Board may deem proper, bearing interest not exceeding the rate of twelve per cent. per annum, for the purpose of erecting a Court House or Houses for said county, which bonds shall be signed by the said Commissioners, and attested by the Clerk of said Board, and under the seal of said county, and when issued and sold, shall be and continue a lien upon said Court House or Houses and the land upon which the same may be erected in said county, until the same are fully paid.

Tax to be levied for payment of interest and principal
 SEC. 2. The Commissioners of said county shall annually levy a tax sufficient to pay the annual interest that may become due on said bonds, and shall annually levy a tax sufficient to pay one-tenth of the principal in each year, which tax collected for the payment of the principal, shall remain in the treasury of the county to cancel the bonds at the time the same shall become due.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.
